PREAMBLE - WHY YOU SHOULD PRAY AND FAST

Ezra 8:23 "So we fasted and begged God to take care of us. And he did." (TLB)

The practice of fasting has strong roots in the Bible. Jesus himself spent time in fasting and prayer during His life on earth, and He expected His followers to fast as well (Matthew 17:20-21). Prayer and fasting are like a Siamese twin; they are inseparable pairs for vibrant spiritual formation, faith development and accessing the blessings of God for your life. Also, medical science has revealed that intermittent fasting affords some physiological health benefits such as improved blood sugar control, heart health, boosted brain function, cancer prevention, lower cholesterol, increased cell turnover, disease prevention, a better night's sleep, and many more. Certainly, these physical benefits are worthwhile but if you truly desire the spiritual and greatest benefits of fasting, it will be of great advantage that you convert the time you would have spent on shopping, cooking, and eating to moments of worship, fellowship, word study, and prayer. These have become proven strategies for unlocking the treasure house of God's blessings upon your life.

During prayer and fasting, believers can experience great measures of physical and spiritual transformation as well as miraculous interventions. Isaiah 58 tells us of the kind of fasting the Lord chose for Himself. And the things He expects us to do. It offers us the opportunity to repent and embrace the acts of justice and righteousness. It is a season for seeking God's face - with a broken, repentant, and contrite spirit, which ultimately secures the attention of God for the healing, deliverance, and interventions for our personal lives, our families, and our extended communities. Prayer and fasting will take you to a place of encounter where God reveals Himself and His plans to you. Yes, you can pray; however, faithless prayers, sinful lives, and reckless living will not stand the assault of the enemies. Prayer and fasting are acts of discipline and faith and they have the potential to deliver according to the purpose of God for the believer.

- i. Fasting and prayer can restore or strengthen your intimacy with God. Many long-time Christians find that fasting helps them rediscover their "first love" for God again.
- ii. Fasting is a way to humble yourself in the sight of God (Psalm 35:13; Ezra 8:21). King David said, "I humbled my soul with fasting" (Psalm 69:10). You may find yourself relying on God more fully for strength when you fast.
- iii. Fasting and prayer can help us hear God more clearly. To listen to God as you fast, consider combining a time of fasting with a practice of listening prayer. Together, fasting and prayer can transform your prayer life into a richer and more personal experience of God.
- iv. Fasting enables the Holy Spirit to reveal your true spiritual condition. When you see your brokenness more clearly, you're able to move toward repentance.
- v. When you experience revival in your own life through fasting, the grace and love of God can shine through you into the lives of others.

The call to pray and to fast is therefore one that must be heeded by every believer because it presents unique and unlimited advantages to the believer. When we pray and fast, it is the practice of two major spiritual disciplines that help us stay aligned to seek God by denying ourselves physical pleasure to concentrate on the spiritual



possibilities and opportunities we have to become like Him and to acquire a deeper knowledge of His will and plans for our lives.

As you embark on this 21-day journey of spiritual encounter and transformation, please set aside all distractions and seek God's face. This year must not go like the previous ones. There must be a difference. This spiritual journey shall profit you in all areas of your life, family, business, and destiny as you draw closer to the God of Supernatural Blessings in Jesus' name! Amen.

In the same manner that God said "I will make you a great nation; I will bless you and make your name great; and you shall be a blessing. I will bless those who bless you and I will curse him who curses you; and in you, all the families of the earth shall be blessed." God is still speaking with men and bringing them into the full experience of this covenant. This year is the year when the Lord will bring you into this covenant and it will begin to work for you in Jesus name!

Day 6 – Saturday, January 13th 2024

ENGAGING THE COVENANT BY GIVING

*"And said: "By Myself, I have sworn, says the Lord, because you have done this thing, and have not withheld your son, your only son - (In) blessing I will bless you, and multiplying I will multiply your descendants as the stars of the heaven and as the sand which is on the seashore; and your descendants shall possess the gate of their enemies. In your seed, all the nations of the earth shall be blessed, because you have obeyed My voice."
(Genesis 22:16-18)*

Yesterday, we saw that our access into the covenant is first by relationship but today, we will see that our acquisition and allocation of the content of the covenant is by responsibility. Giving and stewardship are fundamental parts of the blessing. Abraham was blessed and became a blessing by relationship and by responsibility. Principles and practices are repeatable and under the same conditions, they will produce the same and even better results. We can be blessed and even become channels of blessing just by doing what Abraham did. In Genesis 12, he gave up the comfort and ownership of his father's house; in Genesis 13, he gave Lot a portion of all he had; in Genesis 14, he gave a tithe of all things to Melchizedek, in Genesis 18, he gave and was hospitable to angels; in Genesis 21, he gave Hagar and Ishmael parting gifts and in Genesis 22, he gave up Isaac as a sacrifice to God by faith. This covenant practice of giving activated the possibilities of God's blessings upon him and many others to date.

Giving is an act of worship and it honours God when we give of our substances to Him. Added to this is the fact that our acts of generosity will position us for more of God's blessings. We are told in the scriptures "Give and it shall be given unto you, good measure, pressed down, shaking together and running over shall men give unto you" (Luke 6:38). The implication of this scripture is that nobody lacks what they give. Giving is like sowing a seed; every seed produces after its kind and in measures more than what was planted. When you are a giver, God depends on you for the blessing of others by blessing as you give more. Beloved, if you want the covenant of supernatural blessings to work for you, practice acts of giving/generosity by all means. Be a giver and a distributor of God's resources to others. Give in obedience to God's command – to the needy and the blessed. It is a sign of honour and a way of contacting the grace of God that has made them blessed people. You too can be a giver, do not stay at the receiving end always. May this covenant begin to speak over you.

Day 7 – Sunday, January 14th 2024

BLESSED BY SERVING

And ye shall serve the Lord your God, and he shall bless thy bread, and thy water; and I will take sickness away from the midst of thee. (Exodus 23:25)

We all want our lives to matter and that is the reason why we get involved in the things we do. We chase promotions and leadership positions because we want to make a difference, make lots of money and be relevant. There is absolutely nothing wrong with wealth or influence, but those things alone would not make the world better if we do not serve them. God made each one of us with unique talents, personalities, and skill sets. And when we ask Jesus into our lives, we are given at least one spiritual gift or more. The essence of these blessings is to propel us to serve and add value with them beyond ourselves because there are countless blessings in service. Every time you serve, help others and go out of your way to make something happen for others, God sees it; God is keeping the records. Please note that the way to serve God acceptably is to serve men in a godly way. If we cannot serve men whom we see every day and everywhere, how can we serve God whom we have not seen? This year, take up service roles in church, at home, at work, and in your community. Serve diligently and wholeheartedly. The rewards of the Lord are for those who serve not those who wait to be served.

Day 8 – Monday, January 15th 2024

MY PLANS SHALL SUCCEED

*Ask the LORD to bless your plans, and you will be successful in carrying them out.
Proverbs 16:3 (GNT)*

Nobody plans to fail but people fail to plan. If you fail to plan, you have planned to fail. Planning is largely important for success in life and that is why it is dangerous to enter a New Year without a definite plan. However, it is disastrous to engage such plans without committing them to the Lord and asking for His blessings upon them. How do you explain that in one night, a people that had been in captivity for 430 years would be leaving with the entire wealth and prosperity of their oppressors? The answer is FAVOUR! If your hand is always or sometimes empty, it is traceable to the absence of favour. The evidence of favour is that your hand is never empty. The blessing of favour is that it has the capacity to attract and sustain the grace of increase and abundance upon a man's life. It follows you everywhere you go and makes you replicate the same grace and results at all times. When one who was previously oppressed and denied possessions becomes one who has everything, it is proof that such a person has been favoured beyond imagination. This year, the tables of power and provision have turned around and you shall be favoured beyond imagination.

It is a solemn utterance intended to invoke a supernatural power to inflict harm or punishment on someone or something. It makes a waste of one’s effort and resources. To be blessed indeed means that God will enlarge your capacity to do more and receive more; it means that God's hand will be with you and that the Lord will keep you from evil. It also includes you not causing pain either to yourself or others around you and most importantly, God granting your request. It is on this note that we have come today to ask for nothing but to be blessed indeed. While others may crave or be satisfied with just the drops of the blessing, we need the unending showers of blessings.

Day 15 – Monday, January 22nd 2024

WORKING WITH THE BLESSINGS

SPEAKING THE BLESSINGS

*...Say to them: "The LORD bless you and keep you; The LORD make His face shine upon you,

There is a direct relationship between your words and the quality of your life. What you say affects how you live and what you see. If you choose to speak life and blessing, both yourself and your descendants will "live." You need to learn how to speak a blessing over yourself. God demonstrated the power of speaking words of blessings. God used words to CREATE LIFE (Genesis 1:3), to SUSTAIN LIFE (Hebrews 1:3) and to TRANSFORM LIFE (Hebrews 4:12). The first words God spoke over Adam and Eve were words of blessing. (Gen 1:27-29) The last words Jesus spoke over the assembled group of disciples as He was ascending to Heaven were words of blessing (Luke 24:50-52).

In our culture today, people are more likely to complain, speak negatively and criticize, than to bless. People are more likely to forecast harm than prophesy good. Many people speak negatively with the hope of getting a positive result. This is common among parents who are trying to "motivate" their children to change their behaviour. Our words have great influence in our lives and the lives of those around us. When we speak the blessings, it can bring hope, encouragement, and direction to our lives, families, friends, and others. Speaking the blessings is confessing, verbalizing or declaring a positive, Biblical statement that invokes the blessing of God on your life, the life of another or any concern of yours. These blessings come from God, Who Himself "hath blessed us with all spiritual blessings in heavenly places in Christ" (Ephesians 1:3). To bless also means "to speak well of." When you arise in the morning, do not say, "I am so tired, today is a bad day, life is hard, etc." Declare "Today is a great day! The joy of the Lord is my strength, the Lord is the strength of my life, things are working for me; I am blessed, etc." This year and beyond, be careful what you join others to say or confess. Use the word of God for create your pleasant reality "When they cast thee down, thou shalt say, There is lifting up" (Job 22:29). Proverbs 18:21 (AMP) Death and life are in the power of the tongue, And those who love it and indulge it will eat its fruit and bear the consequences of their words.

Divine healing is the divine intervention of God changing the natural and working the impossible for the health and healing of mankind. God is the Great Physician. He is the omnipotent God, the Creator, and His knowledge of the human soul, mind, and body is absolute. He has made provision for every need in the lives of human beings, and this provision includes healing of the physical body. Jesus manifested to destroy the works of the devil” (1 John 3:8). Hence, along with paying the penalty for our sins, He provided for our healing at an unlimited cost. “Surely, he hath borne [lifted or taken away] our griefs, and carried our sorrows... (Isaiah 53:4). Griefs can be interpreted as physical sickness and disease and sorrows is the same word used in Job 33:19 to denote physical pain. Hence, this verse could be translated, “Surely he hath borne our sicknesses and carried our pain” and that is why we were healed (cured, made whole) by His stripes (Isaiah 53:5). The evidence of this exists in Jesus's ministry on earth – He ministered to both the spiritual needs of the people healed those who were physically afflicted. Hence, sickness was one major means of displaying His power, glory and dominion over the work of Satan. (John 9:3-4).

God's Word gives clear instructions regarding what to do when one is sick. James 5:13-15 – praying, singing of Psalms, calling for the elders, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord. This must be done in faith in order to get results. Looking to God for the healing of the body and emotions is a privilege of God's children and is one of the blessings of serving the Lord (Exo 23:25). However, you must avoid self-inflicted sicknesses by all means as you expect God's healing power to flow into your life. Beloved, God can heal in conjunction with medical help, but He also can and often does heal miraculously, without any human intervention. No matter what means God uses to perform the miracle of healing, Jesus is always the Healer (Exodus 15:26). He alone is to receive the glory for any manifestation of the power of God (Acts 3:12; 14:11-15). Ultimately, you must believe that He wants you to live in health and prosper (3 John 2).

PRAYERS

1. Father, I worship You because all power in heaven and on earth belongs to You
2. Lord, thank You for the potency of Your word and Your name over sicknesses and diseases
3. Father, I align myself with the finished works of Jesus and I therefore live in divine health
4. Lord, I command every seed and root of sickness in my body to dry up and die
5. Every arrow of sickness shot at me, I reject and return it to its senders in Jesus name!
6. The life-giving Spirit of God quickens my mortal body and releases health into my bones
7. I release the blood of Jesus into my blood streams by faith and I flush out all diseases
8. Father, I receive grace and wisdom to embrace healthy habits that produces good health
9. Father, send help to all medical practitioners as they work with You for our health
10. Pray for divine health for our senior citizens and all afflicted individuals



Day 20 – Saturday, January 27th 2024

THE BLESSING OF ALL ROUND REST

"The Lord gave them rest all around, according to all that He had sworn to their fathers. And not a man of all their enemies stood against them; the Lord delivered all their enemies into their hand." (Joshua 21:44)

Rest is the experience of peace and victory over the troubles and the storms of life. Rest is not totally the absence of challenges but the presence of God in the midst of your challenges which guarantees your triumph. Rest is a product of your placement in God's plan because your stand with God is what determines how much rest and peace you enjoy in your life. Ultimately, rest is a gift from God and when He gives it, it is total. As a child of God, do not be carried away by the troubles around the world. It is for this very purpose God has promised you His blessing of rest and peace. Darkness shall cover the earth and you are not the earth. Gross darkness the people, you are not the people, you are different from them. Your portion is rest because God is on your side. You are not in the same class with the world. Yes, you live in the world but you do not belong to the world, you can create your world within the world. Like Joshua, your portion this year is that the Lord will give you rest all around without an exception. His promises shall come to pass over you. Not one of all your enemies will stand against you; the Lord will deliver all of them into your hands.

As this year evolves, keep declaring rest and peace boldly in the face of every storm and trouble. Peace does not connote absence of storm! It means gaining control over the storm when they come. Mark 4:36-39 tells us of Jesus' move to the other side but Himself and the disciples were attacked by a storm. He rose from sleep and commanded the storms to cease and immediately, it did. Beloved, you have to rise to the storm that is rising up against you. Every time you sense some storms, some crisis around you, declare: Peace, be still, rest has come. If you sense a trend that is not consistent with God's word around your life, declare peace. This year, you will not run helter-skelter; there will be no calamity around you. The Lord will trouble those that trouble you and you shall enjoy total rest. Like Solomon, your testimony shall be: "But now the LORD my God has given me rest on every side; there is neither adversary nor evil occurrence. (1 Kings 5:4)

3. I receive the gift of Your rest from all troubles and calamities this year

6. I receive the word of God for this year and the blessing of God's rest is mine
7. Father, I receive rest over my family and my business. No disaster of any kind!
8. Father, we receive rest all around for Nigeria and the world.
9. Lord, we receive the gift of rest for Your church and our leaders this year
10. This year as a church, we reject all adversaries and programmed evil occurrences



Day 21 – Sunday, January 28th 2024

SUSTAINING THE FLOW OF GOD'S BLESSINGS

Ephesians 1:3 All praise to God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly realms because we are united with Christ. (NLT)

On this last day of our fasting and prayer for these 21 days, it is very important for us all to know receiving the supernatural blessings of God and sustaining them is a very important pursuit for every believer. Many stopped at the point of the blessing but they could not sustain it for several reasons. Our test for the year and for today tells us that the only guarantee for God's blessings to continually flow to us is that we stay united with and connected to Christ. Disconnection from Christ will result in a termination of the flow of His blessings. For example, you cannot charge your phone by just plugging the charger to the source of power. For it to charge your phone, you must also connect the charger to the phone and ensure it stays firmly. Partial contact will not charge your phone, as a matter of fact, it can even destroy your device. In the same manner, we must all plug into our union with Christ. And this plugging must be with everything that is related to us. A father will not give what belongs to children to a total stranger. Relationship is fundamental to our inheritance in Christ.

God wants that consistent connection to remain in order to sustain the flow of His blessings to you. You ensure this sustained connection by living to please God, avoiding every act of sin, serving God with your time and your life, giving to advance His cause and to bless His people, making sure that what matters to God matters to you, praying and studying His word, regular appearance in His presence and stretching your faith to take delivery of His blessings. Do not stay idle while there is so much to do this year. The blessings of the Lord are upon those who fear Him and serve Him. Do not envy or desire what those who serve and give have when you are not willing to do what they are doing for God and His people. Stay connected and exemplify your connection by what you do. Remember that Jesus taught us in John 15:4-5 that "As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in Me."

1. Father, thank you for this day of our fast and the blessings You have for me today
2. Blessed be Your name for the strength to journey through this 21-days encounter

10. Give God a victory dance and celebrate the release of His blessings to you this year.

You are already blessed in Christ Jesus with all that you need for life and godliness. It is now your responsibility to make a switch from the natural to the supernatural. It is time to activate your covenant provisions in Christ Jesus through faith and obedience to God's instructions. It is time to make a download of all the supernatural blessings stored up for you in heavenly places in Christ Jesus. It is time to walk in the consciousness of supernatural blessings rather than natural shortcomings.
